



ED attaches Amway India's ₹757-cr. assets

Firm accused of running pyramid scam

The Enforcement Directorate has attached assets estimated at ₹757.77 crore of Amway India Enterprises Private Ltd., which has been accused by the agency of running a multi-level marketing scam. The 36 bank accounts identified so far had a cumulative balance of ₹345.94 crore, the ED said.

The company had collected about ₹27,562 crore through its business operations from 2002-03 to 2021-22, out of which it paid commissions of ₹7,588 crore to its distributors and members in India and the U.S. from 2002-03 to 2020-21, as alleged by the agency.

"Amway has brought ₹21.39 crore as share capital in India in 1996-97 and till 2020-21, the company has remitted a huge amount of ₹2,859.1 crore in the name of dividend, royalty and other payments to their investors and parent entities," it said in a statement, adding that the company ran the "pyramid fraud" under the guise of a direct-selling multi-level marketing network.

"The prices of most of the products are exorbitant as compared to the alternative popular products of reputed manufacturers... The common gullible public is induced to join as members and purchase products at exorbitant prices and are thus losing their hard earned money," the ED said.

Sensex slumps 2% as investors dump bank, technology stocks

'Volatility to persist on rising interest rates globally, and high inflation'

Key benchmark indices fell sharply on Monday following selling pressure in banking and IT stocks. The S&P BSE Sensex slid 1,172.19 points, or 2.01%, to 57,166.74.

The top losers included Infosys, which fell 7.27%, HDFC (4.81%), HDFC Bank (4.74%), Tech Mahindra (4.69%) and Wipro (3.67%).

Similarly, the NSE Nifty index fell 302 points, or 1.73%, to 17,173.65 points.

"Lower-than-expected results from heavyweights like Infosys and HDFC Bank impacted sentiments," said Ajit Mishra, VP, research, Religare Broking Ltd. "Mixed

trend was seen among the sectoral indices wherein IT and banking were the top laggards while auto, FMCG and energy were the gainers.

"We believe global cues as well as the outcome of Q4 earnings will continue to add volatility in the coming sessions. Hence, we would remain cautious on the markets and suggest traders to keep their position hedged," Mr. Mishra added.

"We expect FY23 to witness continued volatility in equity markets, especially in the first half of the year with rising interest rates globally and high inflation, which is expected to persist," Naveen Kulkarni, chief investment officer, Axis Securities, said.

'Debt funds to equity'

"In this scenario, we expect money to move from longduration debt funds to equity funds in the second half of the year, which should bode well for equities," he said.

"We continue to remain positive on... metals, hospitals, hospitality, oil refining, capital goods. Some underperforming sectors might include discretionary consumption, IT, NBFCs," Mr. Kulkarni added.

The BSE SENSEX (also known as the S&P Bombay Stock Exchange Sensitive Index or simply SENSEX) is a free-float market-weighted stock market index of 30 well-established and financially sound companies listed on the Bombay Stock Exchange. The 30 constituent companies which are some of the largest and most actively traded stocks, are representative of various industrial sectors of the Indian economy.

Published since 1 January 1986, the S&P BSE SENSEX is regarded as the pulse of the domestic stock markets in India. The base value of the SENSEX was taken as 100 on 1 April 1979 and its base year as 1978–79. On 25 July 2001 BSE launched DOLLEX-30, a dollar-linked version of the SENSEX.

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TRAI moots up to 40% spectrum price cut

Authority also recommends 36% lower prices for 5G airwaves, easier spectrum surrender norms

The Telecom Regulatory Authority of India (TRAI) on Monday recommended slashing the base price for airwaves by up to 40% across all spectrum bands, including 5G airwaves.

The telecom regulator has also suggested that all available spectrum in the existing bands – 700 MHz, 800 MHz, 2000 MHz, 1800 MHz, 2500 MHz, 2300 MHz, 2500 MHz a should be put up for auction, along with airwaves in new bands such as 600 MHz.

The DoT, in a letter to TRAI in November last year, had emphasised on the need to strike a balance between generating revenue and the sustainability of the telecom sector in a way that telecom service providers are in good health with sufficient capaci-

ties to make regular and substantial capital expenditure for transitioning to 5G technology. It had also highlighted that only 37.1% of the spectrum put up in the previous auction was acquired by telcos and spectrum lying idle was a 'waste for the economy'.

"The inputs received by

the Authority during the consultation process also point to the need for further rationalisation of the reserve price," the regulator said on Monday.

TRAI recommended the slashing of reserve prices across all spectrum bands by up to 40% for a 20-year period compared with the base price suggested in its previous recommendations.

For 5G airwaves in the 3300-3670 MHz band, all-India reserve price comes to ₹317 crore/MHz, lower by 35.5% from the ₹492 crore/MHz recommended earlier. Similarly, the reserve price for the premium 700 MHz band, which saw no takers in the previous auction, had been cut by 40% to ₹3,927 crore/MHz.

Previous auctions

In the last auctions held in March 2021, a total of 2,308.80 MHz spectrum worth ₹4,00,396.20 crore in reserve price was put to auction, out of which 855.60 MHz was sold resulting in total winning bids worth ₹77,820.81 crore. No bids were received for the 700 MHz and 2500 MHz bands.

The regulator also suggested that the reserve price of spectrum allocation for 30 years should be equal to 1.5 times the reserve price of spectrum allocation for 20 years, for the respective bands. "For the long-term growth and sustainability of the sector, infusing liquidity and encouraging investment, telecom service providers should be allowed eapayment options including part payment with flexibility of moratorium."

Further, for ease-of-doing business, easy and transparent spectrum surrender guidelines with a surrender fee of ₹I lakh per spectrum band per licensed service area has been recommended. It also suggested that for the uptake of 5G use cases, a 5G-dedicated Inter Ministerial Working Group should be formed.

The Telecom Regulatory Authority of India is a regulatory body set up by the Government of India under section 3 of the Telecom Regulatory Authority of India Act, 1997. It is the regulator of the telecommunications sector in India.

Every telecom operator has been assigned certain portions of spectrum to use in India, through auctions and administrative allocations. Essentially, you have spectrum "bands", and frequencies around a particular band are then auctioned off.

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SAT admits Ramkrishna's plea against regulator's order

SEBI asked to submit reply in 4 weeks; hearing on June 30

The Securities Appellate Tribunal (SAT) has admitted former NSE chief Chitra Ramkrishna's plea against a SEBI order in relation to governance lapses at the bourse and directed her to deposit an amount of ₹2

The appellate tribunal also directed NSE to deposit more than ₹4 crore towards leave encashment and deferred bonus of Ramkrishna in an escrow account as against SEBI's direction where the amount was to be parked in the Investor Protection Fund Trust.

In an order dated February 11, SEBI had slapped a penalty of ₹3 crore on Ms.

Ramkrishna for alleged governance lapses in a case related to the appointment of Anand Subramanian as the Group Operating Officer and Advisor when she was MD and CEO of the NSE.

Besides, the watchdog had asked NSE to deposit the excess leave encashment of ₹1.54 crore and the deferred bonus of ₹2.83 crore of Ms. Ramkrishna in the Investor Protection Fund Trust.

Passing a four-page order dated April 11, the tribunal said various questions that had been raised would be considered at the time of hearing. It also directed SE-BI to submit its reply within four weeks, while listing the case for hearing on June 30.

"However... to balance the equities as well as balance of convenience, we direct NSE... to deposit ₹4.73 crore towards leave encashment and deferred bonus of the appellant in an escrow account of instead of depositing it in the Investor Protection Fund Trust," the tribunal said.

Chelsea upbeat after big win; Bayern Munich must raise its game to avoid an upset

The Champions League semifinal line-up will be settled this week, with Liverpool and Real Madrid needing to defend two-goal leads to make it through.

The other two games are more evenly poised with Villarreal and Manchester City only holding one-goal advantages. Here is a look at the two games to be played on Tuesday.

Bayern Munich-Villarreal (O-1): Bayern Munich must raise its game to avoid being upset by Spanish club Villarreal and keep alive its hopes for a quadruple of trophies this season. The six-time European champion struggled from the start of the first leg against Villarreal and was far from impressive with a 1-0 home win against relegation-threatened Augsburg in the Bundesliga on Saturday

when it had just four shots on goal and none on target in the first half

Champion in 2020 by beating Paris Saint-Germain, Bayern's title defence was ended by the French side in the quarterfinals last season.

Villarreal is trying to reach the last four of the Champions League for only a second time after 2006. The team based in a city of 50,000 people in southeastern Spain hadn't even made it to the quarterfinals since 2009.

Real Madrid-Chelsea (3-1): Chelsea coach Thomas Tuchel was candidly defeatist after the first leg, declaring the European champion's title defence to be over. A 6-0 Premier League rout of Southampton at the weekend might have restored some confidence after conceding seven goals in its previous two matches.

While Chelsea's Premier League target is just holding onto third place, Madrid is cruising at the top in Spain. So much so, Toni Kroos and Luka Modric were rested in a 2-0 win against Getafe that leaves Madrid 12 points clear.

There is still doubt about whether left back Ferland Mendy will play as he continues to nurse a muscle problem. Madrid has won eight of its last nine games in all competitions, with its lone setback a 4-0 home loss to rival Barcelona in the Spanish league in March.
