



Modi to dedicate RFCL unit at Ramagundam

Date of event to be confirmed soon

Prime Minister Narendra Modi is scheduled to dedicate to the nation the prestigious gas-based urea manufacturing plant of Ramagundam Fertilizers and Chemicals Limited (RFCL) at Ramagundam this month-end.

The Ministry of Chemicals and Fertilizers had indicated to the RFCL management to be prepared for the big event on May 25 or 26 but the date will be confirmed on May 10. Meanwhile, the security agencies have already started their preparatory work, sources said. The commercial operations at the plant to produce 2,200 tonnes of ammonia per day and 3,850 tonnes of urea per day had already started in March last year after a gap of 22 years.

The RFCL is a joint venture between National Fertilizers Limited, Engineers India Limited and Fertilizer Corporation of India, which operated the unit until it stopped production on March 31, 1999. By a 2015 revival package, the plant was commissioned with an investment of ₹6,180 crore.

It was targeted to complete the works by 2018 but quite a few deadlines were jumped since.

RFCL was incorporated on 17th Feb, 2015 for setting up Gas based Urea manufacturing plant at Ramagundam with capacity of 2,200 MTPD Ammonia Unit and 3,850 MTPD Urea Plant at an estimated project cost of 5254.28 crore. Subsequently upon revision of scheduled commercial operation date of project, the cost has been revised to 6175.51 crores

Justice Pardiwala is in line to be CJI

He will be the sixth Supreme Court judge from the Parsi community

Justice Jamshed Burjor Pardiwala, to be sworn in as Supreme Court judge along with Justice Sudhanshu Dhulia on Monday, will be the sixth apex court judge from the Parsi community.

In line to be the third Chief Justice of India from the community, Justice Pardiwala would be top judge for a little over two years and lead the court into the next decade. Justice Pardiwala, in 2015, while hearing a plea by Patidar leader Hardik Patel, had initially observed that "reservation and corruption are two things that have not allowed the country to progress in the right direction", but later expunged the remark when 58 members of the Rajya Sabha petitioned

Chairperson Hamid Ansari for his impeachment. He was critical of the steps taken by the Gujarat government during the COVID-19

The first member of the Parsi community to serve on the Supreme Court was Justice Dinshah Pirosha Madon in the early 1980s. The two Chief Justices of India, Justices Sam Piroj Bharucha and Justice Sarosh Homi Kapadia, were appointed top judges almost 10 years apart. Justice Bharucha was appointed CJI in 2001 and Justice Kapadia in 2010.

Then there were the two "Narimans". Justice Sam Nariman Variava, once a parttime professor of law at Sydenham College in Bombay, was Supreme Court judge between 2000 and 2005.

A decade later, the court witnessed in Justice Rohinton Fali Nariman a brilliant spell and a flurry of judgments in fields of law as varied as death penalty review, free speech and insolvency

Justice Bharucha was the 30th Chief Justice of India. Media reports of the time of his appointment as CJI showed Justice Bharucha described in the legal circles as a stern, fair judge who kept his distance from the political establishment. When the SC pulled up author Arundhati Roy for her writing on the Narmada dam issue, Justice Bharucha gave a dissenting opinion, saying the "court's shoulders are broad enough to shrug off their comments and focus should not shift from the rehabilitation of the oustees". His judgment led to the dismissal of Jayalalithaa as Tamil Nadu Chief Minister.

Justice Variava was a lawyer who practised in the Bombay High Court and appeared in the civil court. He was elevated to the Supreme Court as judge in March

Jamshed Burjor Pardiwala (born on 12 August 1965) is a Judge of Supreme Court of India. He is former Judge of Gujarat High Court.

The chief justice of India (IAST: Bhārat ke Mukhya Nyāyādhīśa), officially the chief justice of the Supreme Court of India, is the chief judge of the Supreme Court of India as well as the highest-ranking officer of the Indian federal judiciary. The Constitution of India grants power to the president of India to appoint, in consultation with the outgoing chief justice, the next chief justice, who will serve until they reach the age of sixty-five or are removed by impeachment. As per convention, the name suggested by the incumbent chief justice is almost always the next senior most judge in the Supreme Court.

Govt. capex to spur jobs, manufacturing, says FinMin

'Impact to boost tax contribution to the exchequer'

The focus on capital expenditure in the recently announced Budget for the current fiscal year will boost manufacturing and tax revenue collections, thereby keeping India on track to becoming a \$5 trillion economy, the Finance Ministry said on Thursday.

Tax revenues in the last fiscal year grew by a record 34% to ₹27.07 lakh crore, which the Ministry said was "a remarkable testimony to the rapid recovery" of the economy following successive waves of COVID-19.

"The central government's focus on making India a global economic po-



werhouse and the host of measures adopted towards this commitment has directly reflected in India's GDP growth in recent years."

"This has translated into increased revenue collection for the exchequer while keeping India well on track towards achieving a \$5-trillion economy," the Ministry said in a statement.

India's GDP is estimated to have touched about \$3 trillion in FY22.

The Ministry said apart from a brief setback owing to COVID-19, the government has maintained the nominal GDP growth above 10% in recent years. GST has been a 'revolutionary step propelling India's GDP'.

"With a big push to capex in the Union Budget of 2022-23, the coming years are going to see a surge in domestic manufacturing as well as growth in employment. These, in turn, will directly boost tax contribution to the exchequer," the Ministry said. Gross corporate taxes in FY22 were ₹8.6 lakh crore compared with ₹6.5 lakh crore in the previous year.

In the last fiscal, direct tax collection rose by a record 49% to ₹14.10 lakh crore, while indirect taxes grew 20% to ₹12.90 lakh crore.

The reform of India's indirect tax regime was started in 1986 by Vishwanath Pratap Singh, Finance Minister in Rajiv Gandhi's government, with the introduction of the Modified Value Added Tax (MODVAT). Subsequently, Prime Minister P V Narasimha Rao and his Finance Minister Manmohan Singh, initiated early discussions on a Value Added Tax (VAT) at the state level. [5] A single common "Goods and Services Tax (GST)" was proposed and given a go-ahead in 1999 during a meeting between the Prime Minister Atal Bihari Vajpayee and his economic advisory panel, which included three former RBI governors IG Patel, Bimal Jalan and C Rangarajan. Vajpayee set up a committee headed by the Finance Minister of West Bengal, Asim Dasgupta to design a GST model.

The GST was launched at midnight on 1 July 2017 by the President of India, and the Government of India.

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MHA gives security clearance to Jet Airways

The Union Home Ministry has granted security clearance to Jet Airways that is planning to relaunch commercial flight operations in the next few months, according to an official document. The Jalan-Kalrock Consortium is currently the promoters of Jet Airways. Earlier, the airline had operated its last flight on April 17, 2019. Last Thursday, the airline conducted its test flight

to and from the Hyderabad airport.

A letter sent by the Civil Aviation Ministry on May 6 informed it about the grant of the security clearance. The letter said, it is "directed to refer to your application... to convey security clearance for change in shareholding pattern of the company/firm, for scheduled operator permit, on the basis of security clearance received from the Ministry of Home Affairs".

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It was really unfair, says Sindhu

The Indian star's dreams of winning gold derailed

Two-time Olympic medallist P.V. Sindhu was left in tears after an "unfair" call by the umpires midway through her semifinal match against Japan's Akane Yamaguchi derailed her dream of winning a gold at the Badminton Asia Championships.

Leading 14-11 in the second game after having won the first game, Sindhu was handed a point penalty for taking too much time to serve between points.

The 26-year-old lost her momentum after that incident, losing 21-13, 19-21, 16-21 to eventually end with a bronze, her second in the continental individual championship.

Reasons for loss

"The umpire told me you're taking a lot of time but the opponent wasn't ready at that point. But the umpire suddenly gave her the point and it was really unfair. I think that was one of the reasons why I lost," said Sindhu

"I mean that is my feeling because at that moment it was 14-11 and could have become 15-11 but instead, it became 14-12 and she took continuous points. And I think it was very unfair. Maybe I would have won the match and played in the final."

"I told the chief referee, he came and said it is already done. As a chief referee, you need to at least make sure what was the mistake. Maybe, he should have seen the replay and done something about it."

Sindhu's father P.V. Ramana said she was extremely disappointed with the decision.

"She was confident of winning a gold this time and so was very disappointed. She was crying when she spoke to me but I told her that it is done and dusted and she should forget about it," Ramanna said.
