



Finland, Sweden inch closer to becoming part of NATO

Bloc chief expects the joining process to be very quick

Finland's government declared a "new era" is underway as it inches closer to seeking NATO membership, hours before Sweden's governing party on Sunday backed a plan to join the trans-Atlantic alliance amid Russia's war in Ukraine.

Russia has long bristled about NATO moving closer to its borders, so the developments will be sure to further anger Moscow.

NATO Secretary-General Jens Stoltenberg said on Sunday the process for Finland and Sweden to join could be very quick. He also didn't expect Turkey to hold up the process.

Speaking after top diplomats from the alliance's 30 member states met in Berlin, Mr. Stoltenberg also expressed his hope that Ukraine could win the war as Russian military advances appear to be faltering.

In Finland, President Sauli Niinisto and Prime Minister Sanna Marin confirmed earlier statements that their country would seek membership in NATO during a joint news conference at the Presidential Palace in Helsinki. The Nordic country, which was nonaligned before changing its stance on NATO, shares a long border with Russia.

The Finnish Parliament is expected to endorse the decision in the coming days. A formal membership application will then be submitted to NATO headquarters in Brussels, most likely at some point next week.

Sweden, also nonaligned, moved a step closer to applying for NATO membership after the governing Social Democratic party met on Sunday and backed the decision. The plan to join the alliance will be discussed in Sweden's parliament on Monday, and Prime Minister Magdalena Andersson's Cabinet will make an announcement later that day.

3. Use 3rd form of verb + is/ am/ are/ was/ were/ been/ being according to the tense in passive voice.


4. There is no passive voice of present/ past/ future perfect continuous sentences and future continuous.

5. Generally, passive voice can be made of transitive verb i.e. verbs which have an object attached to them.

6. Sentences of an intransitive verb cannot be converted into passive voice. They laughed- No passive The laughed at- The teacher was laughed at by them.

In the first sentence, there is no object thus it cannot be converted into passive voice. But in the second sentence 'teacher' is the object thus its passive voice is possible.

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Sensex slumps 2% as investors dump bank, technology stocks

'Volatility to persist on rising interest rates globally, and high inflation'

Key benchmark indices fell sharply on Monday following selling pressure in banking and IT stocks. The S&P BSE Sensex slid 1,172.19 points, or 2.01%, to 57,166.74.

The top losers included Infosys, which fell 7.27%, HDFC (4.81%), HDFC Bank (4.74%), Tech Mahindra (4.69%) and Wipro (3.67%).

Similarly, the NSE Nifty index fell 302 points, or 1.73%, to 17,173.65 points.

"Lower-than-expected results from heavyweights like Infosys and HDFC Bank impacted sentiments," said Ajit Mishra, VP, research, Religare Broking Ltd. "Mixed

trend was seen among the sectoral indices wherein IT and banking were the top laggards while auto, FMCG and energy were the gainers.

"We believe global cues as well as the outcome of Q4 earnings will continue to add volatility in the coming sessions. Hence, we would remain cautious on the markets and suggest traders to keep their position hedged," Mr. Mishra added.

"We expect FY23 to witness continued volatility in equity markets, especially in the first half of the year with rising interest rates globally and high inflation, which is expected to persist," Naveen Kulkarni, chief investment officer, Axis Securities, said.

'Debt funds to equity'

"In this scenario, we expect money to move from longduration debt funds to equity funds in the second half of the year, which should bode well for equities," he said.

"We continue to remain positive on... metals, hospitals, hospitality, oil refining, capital goods. Some underperforming sectors might include discretionary consumption, IT, NBFCs," Mr. Kulkarni added.

The BSE SENSEX (also known as the S&P Bombay Stock Exchange Sensitive Index or simply SENSEX) is a freefloat market-weighted stock market index of 30 well-established and financially sound companies listed on the Bombay Stock Exchange. The 30 constituent companies which are some of the largest and most actively traded stocks, are representative of various industrial sectors of the Indian economy.

Published since 1 January 1986, the S&P BSE SENSEX is regarded as the pulse of the domestic stock markets in India. The base value of the SENSEX was taken as 100 on 1 April 1979 and its base year as 1978–79. On 25 July 2001 BSE launched DOLLEX-30, a dollar-linked version of the SENSEX.

Chirag Shetty, brilliant in + the doubles match in the company of Satwiksairaj Rankireddy, said, "We had this belief of doing well in the competition. We were there to contend because we felt we had the team to win. Once we return from dinner, we will dance, like we do after every victory."

Srikanth, whose unbeaten streak in six matches was the pillar on which India's campaign rested, said "Today is a special day. We don't get to play as a team much. To be in the Thomas Cup final and win, makes it special. And the feeling will take time to sink in."

The Thomas Cup, sometimes called the World Men's Team Championships, is an international badminton competition among teams representing member nations of the Badminton World Federation (BWF), the sport's global governing body. The championships have been conducted every two years since the 1982, amended from being conducted every three years since the first tournament held in 1948–1949.

India is the current champion, having won its first title after beating title holders Indonesia 3-0 in the 2022 edition.

SAT admits Ramkrishna's plea against regulator's order

SEBI asked to submit reply in 4 weeks; hearing on June 30

The Securities Appellate Tribunal (SAT) has admitted former NSE chief Chitra Ramkrishna's plea against a SEBI order in relation to governance lapses at the bourse and directed her to deposit an amount of ₹2 crore.

The appellate tribunal also directed NSE to deposit more than ₹4 crore towards leave encashment and deferred bonus of Ramkrishna in an escrow account as against SEBI's direction where the amount was to be parked in the Investor Protection Fund Trust.

In an order dated February 11, SEBI had slapped a penalty of ₹3 crore on Ms.

Ramkrishna for alleged governance lapses in a case related to the appointment of Anand Subramanian as the Group Operating Officer and Advisor when she was MD and CEO of the NSE.

Besides, the watchdog had asked NSE to deposit the excess leave encashment of ₹1.54 crore and the deferred bonus of ₹2.83 crore of Ms. Ramkrishna in the Investor Protection Fund Trust.

Passing a four-page order dated April 11, the tribunal said various questions that had been raised would be considered at the time of hearing. It also directed SE-BI to submit its reply within four weeks, while listing the case for hearing on June 30.

"However... to balance the equities as well as balance of convenience, we direct NSE... to deposit ₹4.73 crore towards leave encashment and deferred bonus of the appellant in an escrow account of instead of depositing it in the Investor Protection Fund Trust," the tribunal said.

Chelsea upbeat after big win; Bayern Munich must raise its game to avoid an upset

The Champions League semifinal line-up will be settled this week, with Liverpool and Real Madrid needing to defend two-goal leads to make it through.

The other two games are more evenly **poised** with Villarreal and Manchester City only holding one-goal advantages. Here is a look at the two games to be played on Tuesday.

Bayern Munich-Villarreal (O-1): Bayern Munich must raise its game to avoid being upset by Spanish club Villarreal and keep alive its hopes for a quadruple of trophies this season. The six-time European champion struggled from the start of the first leg against Villarreal and was far from impressive with a 1-0 home win against relegationthreatened Augsburg in the Bundesliga on Saturday

when it had just four shots on goal and none on target in the first half.

Champion in 2020 by beating Paris Saint-Germain,

Bayern's title defence was ended by the French side in the quarterfinals last season. Villarreal is trying to reach the last four of the Champions League for only a second time after 2006. The team based in a city of 50,000 people in southeastern Spain hadn't even made it to the quarterfinals since 2009.

Real Madrid-Chelsea (3-1): Chelsea coach Thomas Tuchel was candidly defeatist after the first leg, declaring the European champion's title defence to be over. A 6-0 Premier League rout of Southampton at the weekend might have restored some confidence after conceding seven goals in its previous two matches.

While Chelsea's Premier League target is just holding onto third place, Madrid is cruising at the top in Spain. So much so, Toni Kroos and Luka Modric were rested in a 2-0 win against Getafe that leaves Madrid 12 points clear.

There is still doubt about whether left back Ferland Mendy will play as he continues to nurse a muscle problem. Madrid has won eight of its last nine games in all competitions, with its lone setback a 4-0 home loss to rival Barcelona in the Spanish league in March.
