NATIONAL:

Prime Minister Narendra Modi will initiate the release of the first instalment of central financial assistance under the Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana – Grameen (PMAY-G) over the coming days.





- The scheme aims to build **20 million new houses** in rural areas over the next five years, in addition to the **26 million homes already constructed** in the last decade.
- The events will commence in **Jharkhand on September 15**, where PM Modi will distribute **approval letters to 20,000 beneficiaries**.
- The functions will culminate on PM Modi's birthday, September 17, marking a significant event in his tenure.
- Union Commerce and Industry Minister Piyush Goyal introduced two new online portals during the third Board of Trade meeting.
 - These portals aim to ensure **timely and transparent service delivery** and reduce the need for physical visits to **Commerce Ministry offices**.
 - Jan Sunwai Portal: An online platform designed to provide information and services, including grievance redressal.
- The Prime Minister Narendra Modi-led government has approved infrastructure projects worth ₹3 lakh crore in the first 100 days of its third term.
 - The government aims to invest **₹15 lakh crore** in infrastructure to drive progress and development, with a vision for India to become a developed nation by 2047.
 - PM Modi laid the foundation stone for the Vadhvan Port project in Maharashtra's Palghar district, valued at ₹76,000 crore.
- In a boost to green mobility, the Cabinet approved a Rs 10,900-crore incentive for promotion of electric mobility, including 25 lakh two-wheelers, and another Rs 3,435 crore for uninterrupted operation of more than 38,000 electric buses across cities and towns.
 - PM E-DRIVE Scheme:
 - o **Outlay**: ₹10,900 crore
 - **Duration**: 2 years (replacing the FAME scheme)
 - **Objective**: Promote electric mobility by incentivizing electric vehicles (EVs), including twowheelers, three-wheelers, e-buses, e-ambulances, and e-trucks.





- The Spices Board India has introduced a new mobile application called 'CardsApp', aimed at enhancing cardamom production.
 - The Spices Board aims to empower farmers by leveraging technological advancements like 'CardsApp' to boost productivity and promote sustainable growth in India's cardamom production industry.
- The three new criminal laws will be implemented across the country in two years, said a top government official, listing the achievements of 100 days of the NDA government.
 - New Criminal Laws:
 - Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita: Replaces the Indian Penal Code (IPC) of 1860.
 - Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita: Replaces the Code of Criminal Procedure (CrPC) of 1973.
 - Bharatiya Saksha Sanhita: Replaces the Indian Evidence Act of 1872.
- Prime Minister Narendra Modi inaugurated six Vande Bharat Express trains via video conference from Ranchi.
 - Bihar received four of these trains, enhancing connectivity within the state and beyond.
 - Train Routes:
 - **Tatanagar-Patna:** Covers 451 km in 7 hours and 15 minutes, excluding Mondays. Stops at Chandil, Muri, Bokaro Steel City, Gomoh, Parasnath, Koderma, and Gaya.
 - Gaya-Howrah: Semi-high-speed service with stops at Koderma, Dhanbad, Asansol, and Durgapur.
 - Varanasi-Deoghar: Connects important pilgrimage sites.
 - Bhagalpur-Howrah: Provides Bhagalpur with its first direct link to Howrah, enhancing connectivity under the Malda division of Eastern Railway.
- Commerce and Industry Minister Piyush Goyal launched the Bharat Startup Knowledge Access Registry (BHASKAR) in New Delhi.
 - Serve as a central hub for startups, investors, service providers, and government bodies to collaborate and exchange ideas.

- Build the world's largest digital registry for stakeholders within the startup ecosystem.
- The Department of Telecommunications (DoT) has confirmed that the government will once again cover Mahanagar Telephone Nigam Limited's (MTNL) upcoming interest payment on bonds
 - The government will cover Mahanagar Telephone Nigam Limited's (MTNL) bond interest payment due to financial shortfalls.
 - This marks the **second consecutive instance** of government support for MTNL's interest payments.
 - The first occurred in July 2023.
- The Statistics Ministry plans to use Artificial Intelligence (AI) in the Eighth Economic Census (EC), scheduled from January to December 2025.
- The Indian government has proposed a Rs 6,000-crore initiative to promote precision farming through smart technologies like AI, IoT, and drones.
 - The Smart Precision Horticulture Programme, under the Mission for Integrated Development of Horticulture (MIDH), aims to revolutionise Indian agriculture with technology-driven solutions.
- President of India, Smt. Droupadi Murmu, will inaugurate the 8th India Water Week (IWW) 2024 on 17th September in New Delhi.
 - The theme of IWW 2024

The theme is **"Partnerships and Cooperation for Inclusive Water Development and Management"**, emphasizing the need for cross-sectoral collaboration to achieve sustainable water management.

- During the 4th Anniversary Celebrations of the Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY) in New Delhi, the ICAR-Central Institute of Fisheries Technology (ICAR-CIFT) was officially designated as a Fisheries Incubation Centre under PMMSY.
- The Institute of Chartered Accountants of India (ICAI) has officially approved the second version of its Audit Quality Maturity Model (AQMM 2.0).





- India is set to host the second edition of the Global Food Regulators Summit from September 19-21, 2024, in New Delhi.
 - Organized by the Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI) under the Union Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, the event aims to bring together international experts and regulators to discuss critical food safety regulations.
- Union Minister Jitan Ram Manjhi announced a significant policy change that will benefit womenowned micro and small enterprises (MSMEs) by providing enhanced credit guarantee coverage under the Credit Guarantee Fund Trust for Micro and Small Enterprises (CGTMSE) scheme.
- The Union Cabinet has approved the establishment of the National Centre of Excellence (NCoE) for Animation, Visual Effects, Gaming, Comics, and Extended Reality (AVGC-XR) in Mumbai.
 - The centre will be formed as a Section 8 Company under the Companies Act, 2013.
- The Union Cabinet has taken a significant step towards implementing One Nation One Election by clearing the proposal for simultaneous elections to the Lok Sabha and state Assemblies.
 - This development follows the recommendations of a high-level committee chaired by **former president Ram Nath Kovind**, whose report was presented to the Cabinet.
- Union Cooperation Minister Amit Shah is set to unveil three significant initiatives to transform the Indian dairy sector.
 - These include White Revolution 2.0, and measures to improve financial access for dairy farmers through micro-ATMs and Rupay-Kisan Credit Cards.
 - NDDB will initially fund the White Revolution 2.0, with further support expected from the National Programme for Dairy Development 2.0.
- The Union Cabinet has given the green light to the Pradhan Mantri Janjatiya Unnat Gram Abhiyan, a scheme aimed at improving the socio-economic conditions of tribal communities in India.
 - This initiative will cover approximately **63,000 villages** across tribal-majority areas and **aspirational districts**, benefiting over **5 crore tribal people**.
 - Total Outlay: **₹79,156 crore.**
 - Central Share: ₹56,333 crore.
 - State Share: **₹22,823 crore.**

- The Union Cabinet has approved the continuation of the Pradhan Mantri Annadata Aay Sanrakshan Abhiyan (PM-AASHA) scheme, with a financial allocation of ₹35,000 crore for the 15th Finance Commission cycle, which extends until 2025-26.
- The Union Cabinet cleared the new moon mission Chandrayaan-4 and approved the development of the Venus Orbiter Mission (VOM) as part of the government's vision to explore and study the Earth's closest planet.
- The Union Cabinet, chaired by Prime Minister Narendra Modi, approved a subsidy of ₹24,474.53 crore on Phosphatic and Potassic (P&K) fertilisers for the Rabi season 2024-25 (October 2024 to March 2025).
 - The subsidy falls under the Nutrient Based Subsidy (NBS) scheme, operational since April 1, 2010.
- In a significant step toward ensuring social security for gig and platform workers, the Ministry of Labour & Employment (MoLE) has directed platform aggregators to register their workers on the e-Shram portal.

INTERNATIONAL:

- The World Health Organization (WHO) granted its first authorisation for a mpox vaccine for use in adults, marking a critical step in combating the disease, particularly in Africa.
 - The vaccine is produced by Bavarian Nordic A/S, and its pre-qualification allows global health agencies like GAVI and UNICEF to purchase it.
- Former President Donald Trump launched a new cryptocurrency venture called World Liberty
 Financial just 50 days before Election Day.
 - World Liberty Financial is designed to be a crypto banking service that allows users to borrow, lend, and invest in digital currencies.
- The 55th International Film Festival of India (IFFI) 2024 is slated to be held in Goa from 20th to 28th November 2024.

 - September 23: Participation in the Summit of the Future at the UN General Assembly, along with bilateral meetings and a roundtable with CEOs of American firms.
- Cambodian Prime Minister Hun Manet announced that Angkor Wat has been recognized as the most photogenic UNESCO World Heritage site in Asia by Times Travel.
- The World Health Organization (WHO) has congratulated Jordan for becoming the first country in the world to be officially verified as having eliminated leprosy.

BANKING & FINANCE:

<mark>RBI</mark>

- According to Reserve Bank of India (RBI) data, India's outward foreign direct investment (FDI) commitments rose by \$1 billion to \$3.21 billion in August 2024, up from \$2.29 billion in August 2023.
 - Three Components: Outward FDI commitments are classified into three categories: equity, loans, and guarantees.
- The Reserve Bank of India has imposed a penalty of Rs 31.8 lakh on BNP Paribas for noncompliance with certain directions issued by RBI on 'Interest Rate on Advances'.
- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) plans to comprehensively revamp its currency management infrastructure over the next 4-5 years to meet future cash demands of the growing economy.
 - CIC Growth:Coins in Circulation (CIC) volume also increased to 132.35 bpcs by March 31, 2024, from 127.92 bpcs a year earlier.

<mark>SEBI</mark>

- The Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) has decided to shorten the time taken for credit of bonus shares and their subsequent trading to two days from the record date.
 - This new rule will apply to all bonus issues announced from October 1.
- The Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) has approved amendments to the National Stock Exchange (NSE) memorandum of association, allowing a 10-fold increase in authorised share capital to ₹500 crore.

MISCELLANEOUS

- The State Bank of India (SBI) plans to raise up to ₹7,500 crore through the issuance of a second tranche of Tier-II bonds.
 - Bond Details: The bonds have a maturity period of 15 years.
 - The issuance includes a base size of ₹4,000 crore with an additional greenshoe option of ₹3,500 crore.
 - Credit Rating: The bonds are rated "AAA" by ICRA and India Ratings and Research, indicating high credit quality.
- Bank of Baroda (BoB) is planning to launch 7 phygital branches as a pilot project across the country.
 - These branches integrate self-service and assisted service models.
 - The first phygital branch was opened at Horniman Circle, Mumbai in July.
 - The second branch was inaugurated at Vile Parle, Mumbai, and another branch at Chanda Nagar, Hyderabad.
- State Bank of India's (SBI's) cost-to-income (C/I) ratio sharply increased to 60% in FY24 from
 56.2% in FY23 due to higher employee expenses.

- S&P Global Ratings forecasts that SBI's C/I ratio will normalize to 54-55% over the next two years as the bank improves operating efficiency and leverages digital platforms.
- Life Insurance Corporation of India (LIC) increased its stake in Indian Railway Catering and Tourism Corporation (IRCTC) to approximately 9.3%.
- The National Payments Corporation of India (NPCI) has increased transaction limits for tax payments using the Unified Payments Interface (UPI), allowing people to transfer Rs 5 lakh in a single transaction.
 - Applicability: The Rs 5 lakh limit applies exclusively to tax payments.
- PhonePe, a Walmart group fintech firm, partnered with Liquid Group, a cross-border payment solutions provider, to expand its merchant acceptance network in Singapore.
 - QR codes will be available at tourist-centric locations, such as Changi Airport, duty-free shops, restaurants, bars, retailers (e.g., The Cocoa Trees, Hard Rock Cafe), sightseeing spots, and transportation services.
- In pursuance of the announcement in the Union Budget 2024-25, Union Minister for Finance and Corporate Affairs Smt. Nirmala Sitharaman will launch the NPS Vatsalya scheme on September 18, 2024, in New Delhi.
 - Online Platform: An online platform will be introduced for subscribing to NPS Vatsalya.
 - Scheme Brochure: The brochure of the scheme will be released.
 - PRAN Cards: **Permanent Retirement Account Number (PRAN) cards** will be distributed to new minor subscribers.
- Fintech start-up Moneyview became the sixth unicorn in 2024 after raising \$4.6 million (INR 38.6 Cr) from Accel India and Nexus Ventures.
 - After approval from the company's board, 60.23 lakh equity shares were allotted to Accel India and Nexus Ventures.
 - In 2023, only two unicorns were created, which include quick commerce start-up Zepto and fintech start-up InCred Finance.
- > Axis Bank is expanding its private banking business, Burgundy Private, to 15 new cities.

- The country's biggest private sector lender, HDFC Bank, looks to increase the income of 5 lakh marginal farmers earning less than Rs 60,000 annually by 2025 as part of its corporate social responsibility (CSR) initiative, Parivartan.
 - Parivartan Overview: Launched in 2014, Parivartan is one of India's largest CSR programs, active in 28 states and 8 Union Territories, with a focus on rural development and sustainable livelihoods.
- The Life Insurance Corporation of India (LIC) has selected IT major Infosys to develop its NextGen digital platform.
 - The NextGen Digital Platform will be **modular**, **flexible**, **cloud-native**, and have platform driven architecture which will be capable of quickly adopting innovative technologies, new products and features.
- ICRA ESG Ratings Limited has assigned its first Environmental, Social, and Governance (ESG) rating to InCred Financial Services, a Non-Banking Financial Company (NBFC).
 - ICRA ESG was previously known as Pragati Development Consulting Services Limited (PDCSL).
- Star Health and Allied Insurance Company Limited (Star Health Insurance) and Policybazaar announced the launch of 'SUPER STAR', a personalised long-term health insurance plan which is customer-centric in nature with an objective of delivering greater customer value.
- AU Small Finance Bank (AU SFB) and Kotak Life announced a partnership to offer life insurance and financial security solutions.
 - This collaboration is a continuation of Kotak Life's previous relationship with the former
 Fincare Small Finance Bank, which is now merged with AU SFB.

- The Asian Development Bank (ADB) has assured Pakistan of providing \$2 billion annually in new loans from 2024 to 2027, totalling \$8 billion over four years.
- The World Bank pledged an additional \$2 billion in financing to Bangladesh during this fiscal year to support critical reforms, flood response, air quality improvement, and healthcare.
- The State Bank of India (SBI) raised ₹7,500 crore through its second Basel III-compliant Tier-2 bond issuance of the current fiscal year.
 - The bonds have a coupon rate of **7.33%** and a 15-year maturity with a call option after 10 years and on each anniversary thereafter.
 - Total Fundraising for FY: For the current financial year, SBI has raised a total of ₹15,000 crore through Basel III-compliant Tier-2 bonds.
- Bank of Baroda (BoB) has introduced 'Aditi', a GenAl-powered virtual relationship manager, to enhance the digital customer service experience.
 - 'GyanSahay.Al' Knowledge Management Platform: BoB also launched a GenAl-enabled knowledge management platform called 'GyanSahay.Al' for its employees.
- The "One State, One RRB" policy, aimed at consolidating Regional Rural Banks (RRBs) for operational efficiency, is in the drafting phase.
 - As per the **Department of Financial Services (DFS)**, draft rules for the policy will be completed by the end of **September 2024**.
- Jana Small Finance Bank has launched a new "Liquid Plus" fixed deposit offering, providing an interest rate of 6.75% per annum for tenures ranging from 7 to 180 days.
 - This rate applies to a minimum deposit of ₹10 lakhs for retail deposits up to ₹3 crores, and for bulk deposits between ₹3 crores and ₹200 crores per customer.

STATE NEWS:

Union Home Minister Amit Shah announced the renaming of Port Blair, the capital of Andaman & Nicobar Islands to "Sri Vijaya Puram" as a move to "free the nation from colonial imprints."

- The renaming is aimed at removing colonial legacies associated with the original name, Port Blair, which was named after British naval surveyor Archibald Blair.
- The Gujarat government has set up the Gujarat State Institution for Transformation-GRIT under Chief Minister Bhupendra Patel's chairmanship.
 - $\circ~$ The body will act as a policy think tank on the lines of NITI Ayog.
 - A **10-member executive committee** will be in place for the day-to-day operations of GRIT.
- The first semiconductor park in Uttar Pradesh will be established in Greater Noida, near the upcoming Noida International Airport.
 - The Uttar Pradesh government has allocated 225 acres of land in Sector 10 and Sector 28 for semiconductor manufacturing projects by three companies.
- Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath inaugurated the Jatayu Conservation and Breeding Centre in the Bharivaisi, Campierganj Range of the Gorakhpur Forest Division.
 - The Uttar Pradesh Forest Department, in collaboration with the Bombay Natural History Society (BNHS), established the centre.
 - The centre is spread over 1.5 hectares in the Gorakhpur Forest Division and was constructed at a cost of **Rs 2.8 crore**.
- The 9th Ladakh Zanskar Festival 2024 began with remarkable grandeur in the picturesque village of Sani, signifying a landmark event for the region.
 - The festival was inaugurated by Lieutenant Governor Brigadier (Dr) BD Mishra.
- The Assam government has launched Orunodoi 3.0, a women-centric financial assistance scheme aimed at providing monthly financial support to economically disadvantaged families in the state.
 - This is part of the broader efforts by the Assam government to uplift marginalised communities and ensure financial stability for vulnerable households.
 - Initially targets 12 lakh additional beneficiaries, aiming to cover a total of 37 lakh women by early 2025.
- At the 4th Global Renewable Energy Investors Meet and Expo, hosted for the first time outside Delhi, Gujarat emerged as the top performer, winning the maximum number of awards.

BUSINESS NEWS:

- Bengaluru-based athleisure sportswear start-up Agilitas Sports has received an undisclosed strategic investment from Spring Marketing Capital.
 - The investment aims to help **Agilitas Sports** scale its operations and become a categorydefining leader in the **sportswear industry**.
 - Agilitas Sports was founded in 2023 by former Puma India managing director Ganguly, alongside Atul Bajaj and Amit Prabhu.
- The Directorate General of GST Intelligence (DGGI) identified the highest-ever GST evasion in FY24, totalling Rs 81,875 crore across 78 cases in the online money gaming industry.
- Union Labour Minister Mansukh Mandaviya announced significant updates regarding the Employees' Provident Fund Organisation (EPFO), a government-managed retirement savings fund, introducing enhanced flexibility for subscribers and changes to withdrawal limits and eligibility criteria.
 - New Limit: Subscribers can now withdraw up to ₹1 lakh from their EPFO accounts for personal financial needs.
 - Previous Limit: The withdrawal limit was ₹50,000, but it was deemed insufficient due to rising living and consumption costs.
- India's trade deficit soared to a 10-month high of \$29.7 billion in August 2024, driven by record imports of \$64.4 billion and a contraction in exports for the second consecutive month.
- India's wholesale price index (WPI)-based inflation dropped to a four-month low of 1.31% in August 2024, down from 2.04% in July 2024.
- ► India's exports experienced their sharpest decline in 13 months, falling by 9.3% in August 2024 to ₹2.91 lakh crores (\$34.71 billion).
- The Centre has announced a partial restoration of wheat allocation for beneficiaries of the Pradhan Mantri Gareeb Kalyan Ann Yojana (PMGKAY), a major social welfare scheme providing free food grains to over 800 million poor individuals.

 - In August, Navi processed 88.71 million UPI transactions worth Rs 4,651.32 crore.

MOUS AND AGREEMENT:

- The Indian government has approved Anushakti Vidhyut Nigam Ltd. (ASHVINI), a joint venture between Nuclear Power Corporation of India Limited (NPCIL) (51%) and NTPC Ltd (49%), to build, own, and operate nuclear power plants across India.
 - This move is aimed at accelerating the country's nuclear power capacity expansion to meet long-term energy goals, including the **net zero target by 2070**.
- The Cotton Association of India (CAI) and the Liverpool-based International Cotton Association Ltd (ICA) have signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) to enhance cooperation and promote fair business practices in the cotton industry.

- A Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) was signed between the US Department of Defence's Defence Innovation Unit (DIU) and India's iDEX (Innovations for Defence Excellence) of the Ministry of Defence's Defence Innovation Organization (DIO) at the INDUS-X Summit in California.
- Indian Sugar & Bio Energy Manufacturers Association (ISMA) has signed Memoranda of Understanding (MoUs) with The Energy and Resources Institute (TERI) and PRAJ Industries.
- China's central bank, the People's Bank of China (PBoC), has signed a memorandum of understanding (MoU) with the Maldivian Ministry of Economic Development and Trade to strengthen trade and investment.
 - China, as the **largest bilateral lender** to the Maldives, has been in talks with the **Maldivian government** regarding its **debt**.
 - The Maldives owes \$1.37 billion to China and \$124 million to India in loans, according to World Bank Data.
